

Log in to Your Library Account

You can access your library account by clicking on the “My Account” tab at the top of the page.



You will need your Borrower ID and PIN to login.

Your **Borrower ID** is your Champlain student number.

Your **PIN** is a 4 digit code based on your date of birth. It consists of 1) the last digit of your birth year, 2) the last digit of your birth month, and 3) the two digits of your birth day. For example, if you were born on November 5th, 1992, your PIN would be 2105 (2 for 1992, 1 for November, 05 for the 5th).
