For research purposes, Statistics Canada publications are considered primary sources for Canadian social and economic information.

Data Collection:

- Time series (CANSIM) – collected regularly – monthly, quarterly, yearly
- Census – every 5 years
- Surveys - occasional - e.g. General Social Survey, National Longitudinal Survey of Children and Youth, Labour Force Survey, etc.

Data Publication:

- **Statistics Canada Webpage:** www.statcan.gc.ca
- **Summary Tables:** paper, microfiche, CD-ROM, online
- **Census** paper, CD-ROM, online
- **Community Profiles:** online –include data from various Statistics Canada sources.
- **Publications:** paper, online - include survey results, technical papers, periodical magazines, census products and research compendia.

Statscan Periodicals: are indexed on the website and selected articles are available fulltext.

The Library subscribes to the paper format and keeps back issues (except where indicated with an *). Check the Library catalogue for holdings and location.

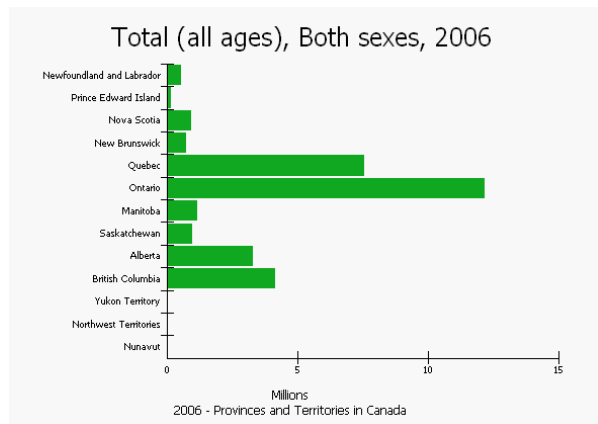

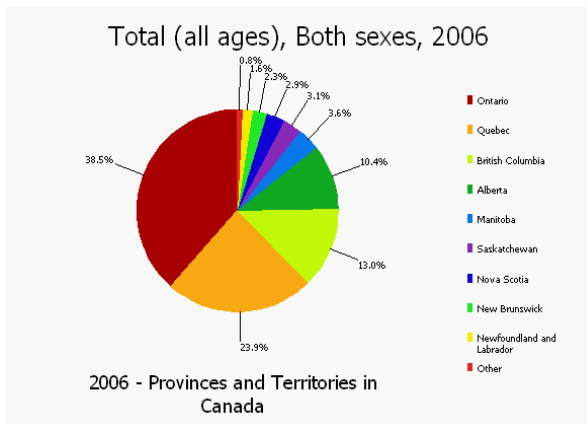
